Helsinki-Uusimaa Region

- Home to 1.8 million inhabitants, which is more than a quarter of the country's total population
- The most urbanized area in Finland, but outside the Metropolitan Region there are still small towns, villages and rural areas
- Situated on the south coast of Finland, with the Baltic
 Sea playing a major role in the region's life
- Helsinki-Uusimaa Regional Council is one of 18 Regional Councils in Finland, responsible for the regional development and land use planning





International co-operation

- Focus on the Baltic Sea Region, where the most important partners also come from
- Active member of networks, such as the Baltic Sea States Subregional Co-operation (BSSSC) and the Conference of Peripheral Maritime Regions (CPMR) with its Baltic Sea Commission
- Networking and liaison
- EU project development, support and partner search
- Maintaining a representative office in Brussels

Bilateral agreement with the Union of Harju County Municipalities

- Helsinki-Uusimaa Regional Council has signed a cooperation agreement with the Union of Harju County Municipalities in 2022
- Four main areas of cooperation include:
 - 1. Integration of regional innovation ecosystems
 - 2. Promoting infrastructure and mobility solutions
 - 3. Climate and sustainability challenges and solutions
 - 4. Resilience and civil protection
- Action Plan drafted together in 2023
- 2024 emphasis on promoting infrastructure and mobility solutions
